Course Location: DeFelice Marine Center, Cocodrie, Louisiana

- **Science Communication to Meet Your Career Goals- \$975/person** (includes meals, housing, course fees)

Course Description: This course will give aspiring and early-career scientists the time, tools, and guidance they need to identify how science communication can advance their career and to construct a personal communications plan. Participants will gain practical skills through a variety of laboratory, field and networking events.

- **Small Boat Operations for Marine Scientists - \$975/person** (includes meals, housing, course fees, certifications)

Course Description: Attendees will receive a recreational safe power boating certification from NASBL and an introduction into the best practices of using powerboats in scientific research programs.

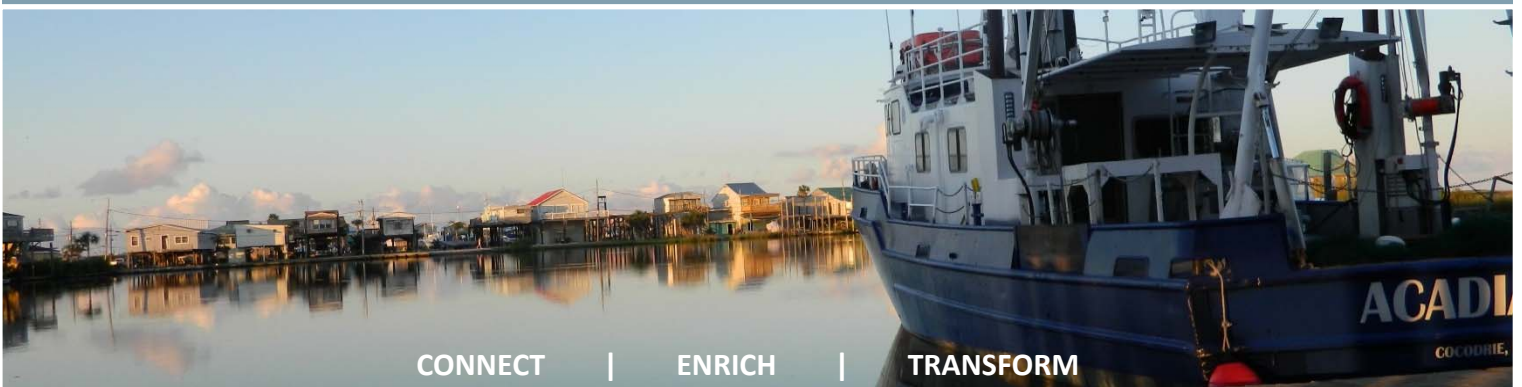
- **Communicating Coastal Concepts through Photography and Video - \$975/person** (includes meals, Housing, course fees)
- Course Description:** Students will learn skills in lens-based image collecting and Louisiana coastal ecology in a variety of field-based experiences. With their collected images students will create a narrative about complex coastal concepts.

- **Scientific Diving Field Camp - \$1600/person** (includes meals, housing, course fees)

Course Description: This course is a two-week scientific diver field course developed to meet AAUS standards for scientific diver accreditation within research or academic programs. The course will include academic course work and testing, pool training, and dives aboard LUMCON research vessels.
