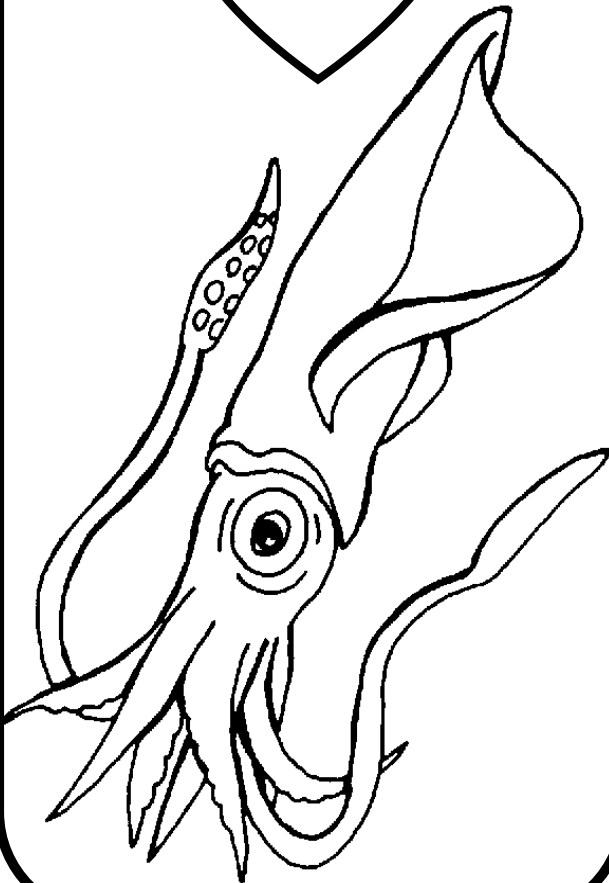
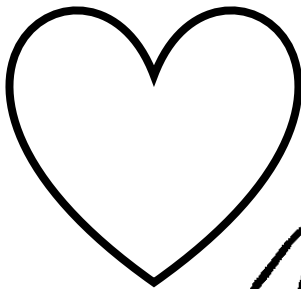


The Squid

Directions:

Squid are in a group of animals called mollusks. This group also includes octopuses, snails, and oysters are all part of a group called Mollusks. Mollusks are animals that have soft bodies, and shells- or at least a feature that was once a shell.

Squid Facts:

- They have 8 arms (for holding) and 2 tentacles (for grabbing).
- Squids have an internal structure called a pin that makes up what is left of their shell.
- Squid have cells called chromatophores. These are pigment cells that expand and contract for communication and camouflage.
- They also have a beak not unlike a beak of a parrot. The function of the beak is to break down food into smaller pieces.
