Storage

Refrigerated/freezer storage	\$60/cubic foot/month

Dry storage up to 10 cubic feet – additional months	\$75/month
Grounds storage up to 20 cubic feet – first month	\$200.00
Grounds storage up to 20 cubic feet – additional months	\$100/month

Additional Fees

Sampling access to LUMCON marshes, harbor, canals, or grounds	\$50/usage
Office or desk space	\$4/square foot/month
Laboratory or bench space	\$4/square foot/month
Incubators	\$20/week
Environmental Chambers	\$100/week

*During priming periods, fees are 50% of daily rate charged during experimental periods. Rentals for extended periods may qualify for a discounted rate.
