During camp, students will continue their journey of becoming highly skilled professionals, creative problem solvers, and leaders of collaborative teams that will view our coast and the Gulf of Mexico as an integrated system.

- environmental monitoring & observational science
- engineering for water environments
- fluid dynamics and physical properties of water
- life in aquatic systems
